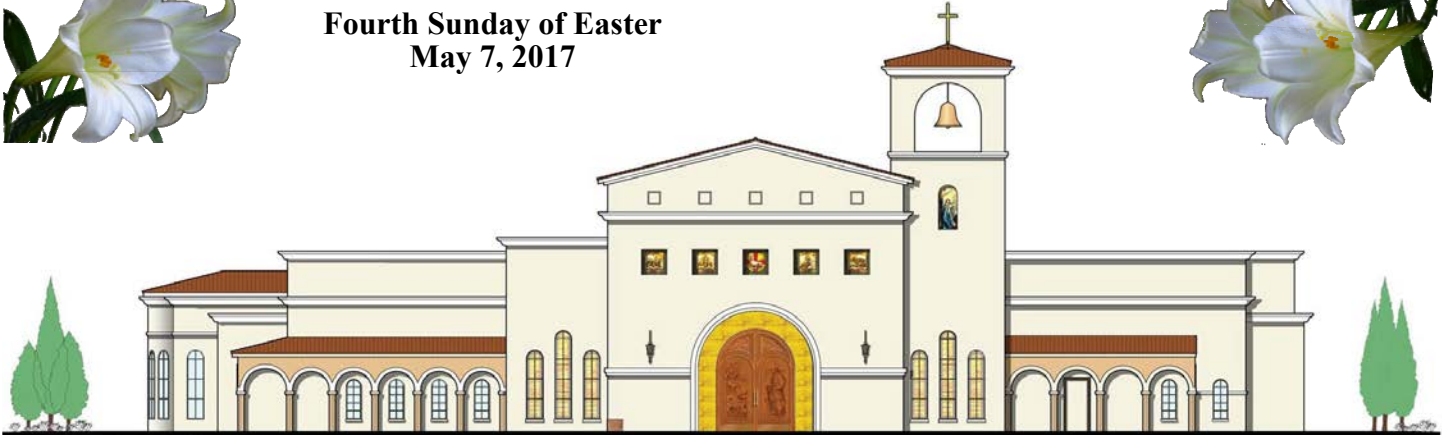

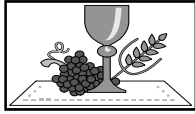

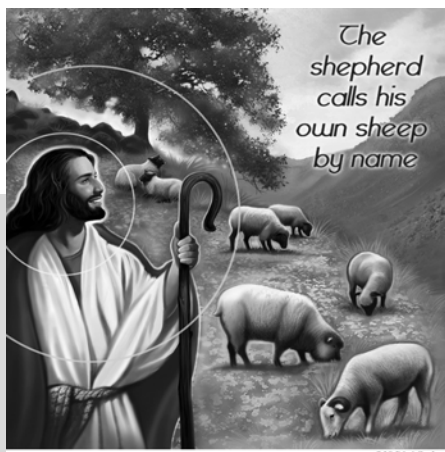


Stewardship – is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God's gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.

Sunday Reading Reflection:

Shepherds and sheep were so much a part of life for Jesus and those from Galilee. Galilee was, after all, largely a rural area and raising sheep and shepherding was an intricate part of their lives. That is why the image of a shepherd with his sheep was so often used during biblical times. It was a connection with which people could identify.

It is equally important for us today to understand this important cultural connection for them. Shepherding was all about feeding the lambs and the sheep (recall that Jesus tells Peter "Feed my sheep."), bringing them to good pasture



Reflexión de las lecturas:

Pastores y ovejas eran una parte tan importante de la vida de Jesús y los de Galilea. Galilea, después de todo, era en gran medida una zona rural y la cría de ganado ovino fue una intrincada parte de sus vidas. Es por ello que la imagen de un pastor con sus ovejas se usan tan a menudo durante los tiempos bíblicos. Era una conexión con las personas que se podían identificar.

Es igualmente importante para nosotros hoy en día el comprender esta relación cultural importante para ellos. El pastoreo fue todo acerca de la alimentación

lands and water ("The Lord is my shepherd...He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside quiet waters; he restores my soul."); going after lost lambs ("Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?"); and protects the sheep in the field and the fold ("The watchman opens the gate, and the sheep listen to his voice.").

Our Gospel reading today comes from St. John 10: 1-10. In St. John 10: 11, the next verse, Christ declares "I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep." As Catholics and Christians, we, too, are called to be Good Shepherds to all those with whom we come in contact. It may be from another culture than ours, but we should understand full well the implications of that.

Nuestra lectura del evangelio de hoy viene de San Juan 10: 1-10. En San Juan 10: 11, el siguiente versículo, Cristo declara "Yo soy el buen pastor; el buen pastor da su vida por las ovejas." Como católicos y cristianos, también nosotros estamos llamados a ser Buenos Pastores a todos aquellos con los que entramos en contacto. No puede ser de otra cultura que la nuestra, pero debemos comprender perfectamente las consecuencias de eso.

Why do Catholics Genuflect?

Catholics genuflect in Church in order to show our reverence to the True Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

The practice of **genuflecting** before the Blessed Sacrament, whether enclosed in the tabernacle or exposed in a monstrance, is a beautiful sign of adoration. This physical act of genuflection symbolizes our heart bowing before the Lord who is substantially and really present in the Eucharist.

Following the same line of thought, kneeling also holds a special place in fostering a proper reverence. Going back to our Lord's time, the Jewish people often stood while praying; however, when the occasion was solemn, the petition urgent, or the prayer was offered with great fervor, then the person humbly knelt before his God to pray. For instance, when Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, the gospel reads, He "went down on His knees and prayed..." (Luke 22:41).

Genuflection is defined as 'A reverence made by bending the knee, especially to express adoration of the Blessed Sacrament' (CCC 1378). As we walk into the house of God, a church, we show our adoration for Him by kneeling before Him.

'Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker.' (Psalm 95:6)

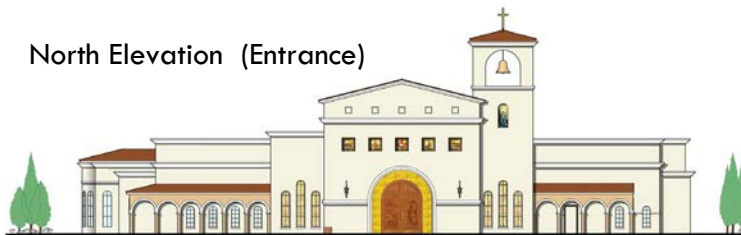

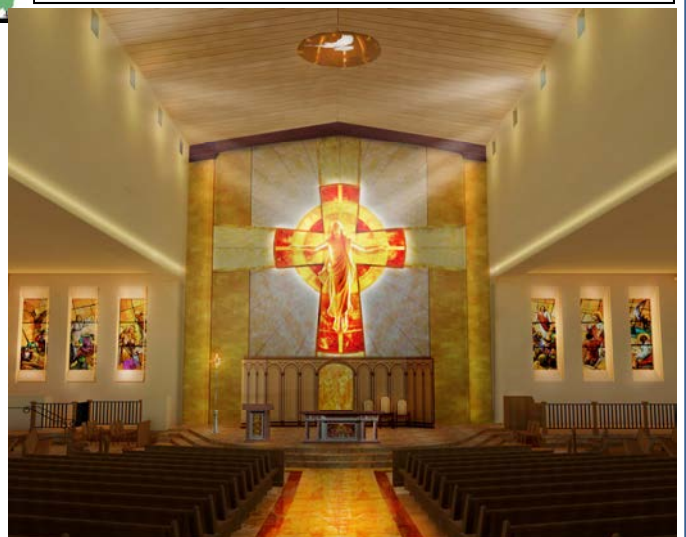
