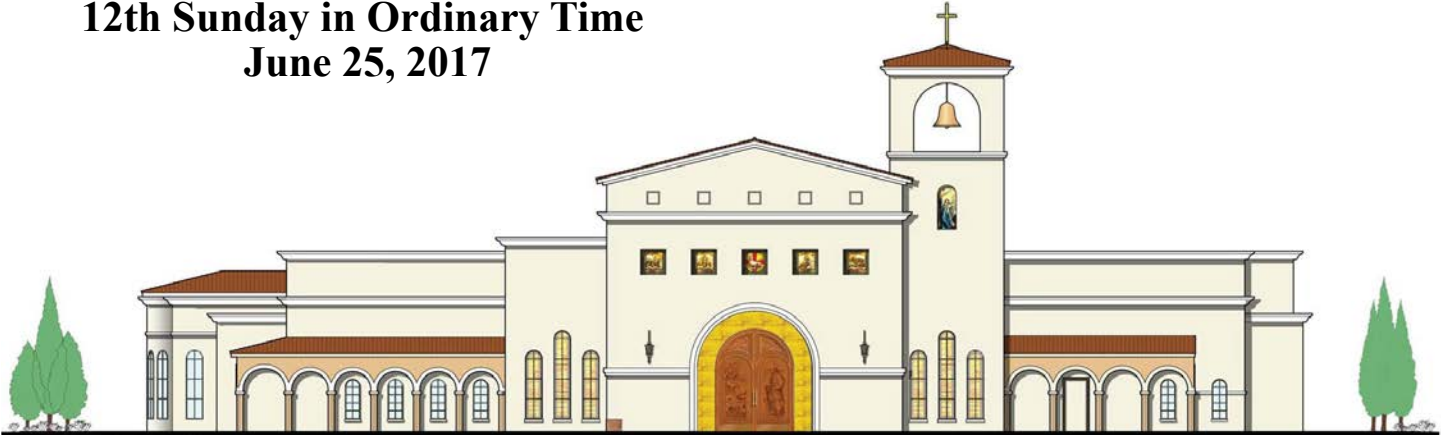

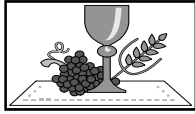

Stewardship - is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God's gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.

Sunday Reading Reflection:

We are reminded in today's readings that we are human, and that as a result of that we are sinners, and we inherit that sin from the very beginning, from Adam. St. Paul points that out in our Second Reading from Romans 2. Were you aware that in Hebrew the name Adam means "humanity?"

In today's Gospel Reading from

Matthew, Jesus also reminds us of the fact that we are sinners, but He also prompts us to remember that one of the reasons we sin is because we fear other humans and the consequences of living out our faith more than we fear the Lord Himself. Jesus says, "...do not be afraid of those who kill the body, but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna."

than we fear God. If we are "killed" by someone or something on earth it is the body only which dies. However, shrinking back from God's call can have eternal consequences.

"Saving grace" and being saved are probably not thoughts on which we like to dwell, but they are real, and we need to recognize that. St. Alphonsus Liguori wrote, "The saved are few, but we must live with the few if we would be saved with the few. O God, too few indeed they are; yet amongst those few I wish to be."

Reflexión de las lecturas:

Se nos recuerda en las lecturas de hoy que somos humanos y que, como consecuencia de que somos pecadores, y que hemos heredado el pecado desde el principio, desde Adán. San Pablo hace referencia a esto en nuestra segunda lectura de Romanos 2. Se es consciente de que en hebreo el nombre Adán significa "humanidad?"

Hoy en la lectura del Evangelio de Mateo, Jesús nos recuerda no nada

tememos al Señor mismo. Jesús dice, "...no temáis a los que matan el cuerpo, pero no pueden matar el alma; más bien, temed a aquel que puede destruir el alma y el cuerpo en la Gehenna."

"Gehenna" se traduce en algunas versiones de la Biblia como "Infierno." Lo que el Señor está intentando comunicarse con nosotros puede ser que probablemente tienden a temer los asuntos terrenales y más que a las personas

debemos de tener temor de Dios. Si estamos "muertos" por alguien o algo en la tierra es sólo el cuerpo que muere. Sin embargo, la reducción de la llamada de Dios puede tener consecuencias eternas. "Gracia salvadora" y ser salvado probablemente no son pensamientos que nos gustaría habitar, pero son reales, y tenemos que reconocerlo. San Alfonso de Liguori escribió, "los salvados son pocos, pero debemos vivir con los pocos, si queremos ser salvados con unos pocos. Oh Dios, de hecho, son muy pocos; sin embargo, entre los pocos que quiero ser".

Catholic Teaching Ask Esther:

Liturgy Of The Eucharist

The Liturgy of the Eucharist begins with the preparation of the gifts and the altar. As the ministers prepare the altar, representatives of the people bring forward the bread and wine that will become the Body and Blood of Christ. The celebrant blesses and praises God for these gifts and places them on the altar, the place of the Eucharistic sacrifice. In addition to the bread and wine, monetary gifts for the support of the Church and the care of the poor may be brought forward. The Prayer over the Offerings concludes this preparation and disposes all for the Eucharistic Prayer.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (no. 79) provides the following summary of the Eucharistic Prayer

History Of The Eucharistic Prayer

The Eucharistic Prayers at the heart of our liturgy have a long history, beginning with the extemporaneous prayers of the early Christians. The presiders gave thanks from their hearts, not from any prearranged text, over the gifts of bread and wine. When the assembly had the sense that enough was said, someone would call out "Amen!" and that was that. For the most part, the plan flowed directly from Jewish meal prayers, which always recalled God's mighty deeds. Some other markers and signposts were added almost everywhere fairly early, like the presider's call to attention: "Lift up your hearts!"

Scholars have provided us with translations of many early texts. These have actually helped us craft new liturgical prayers, because until the liturgical reforms of forty years ago, no one could recall any prayer but the Roman Canon, now called Eucharistic Prayer I. For hundreds of years in the West, it was our only Eucharistic Prayer, and it was only in Latin. But the history of our Eucharistic Prayers is amazingly fruitful, and models have come down to us that have yielded new insights and expressions. The old custom of improvising texts according to a master plan has not endured, but we have now rediscovered a plan of standardizing the text while allowing for a great variety.

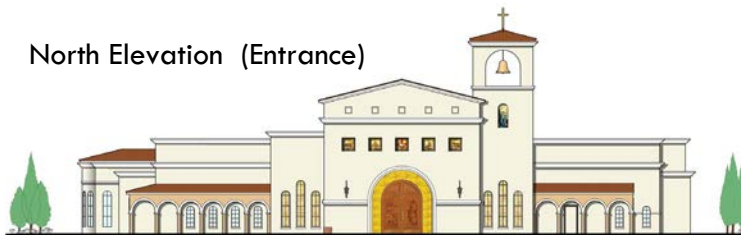

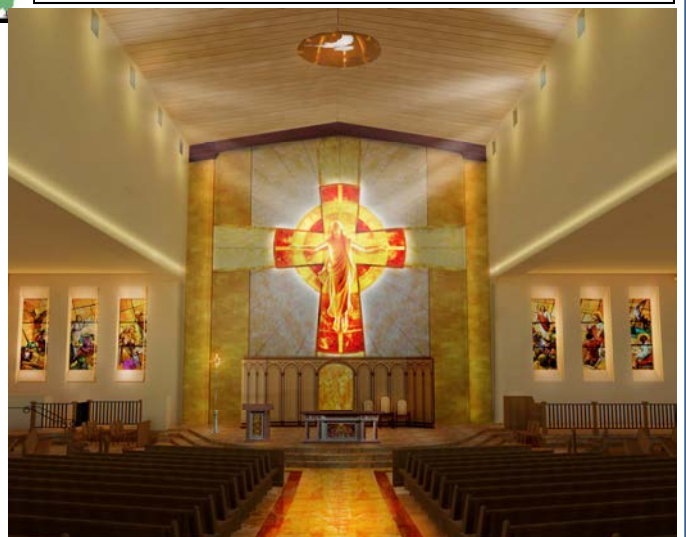

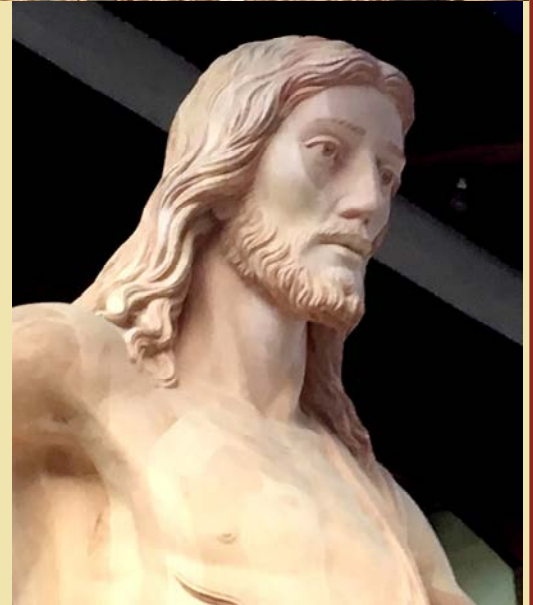
