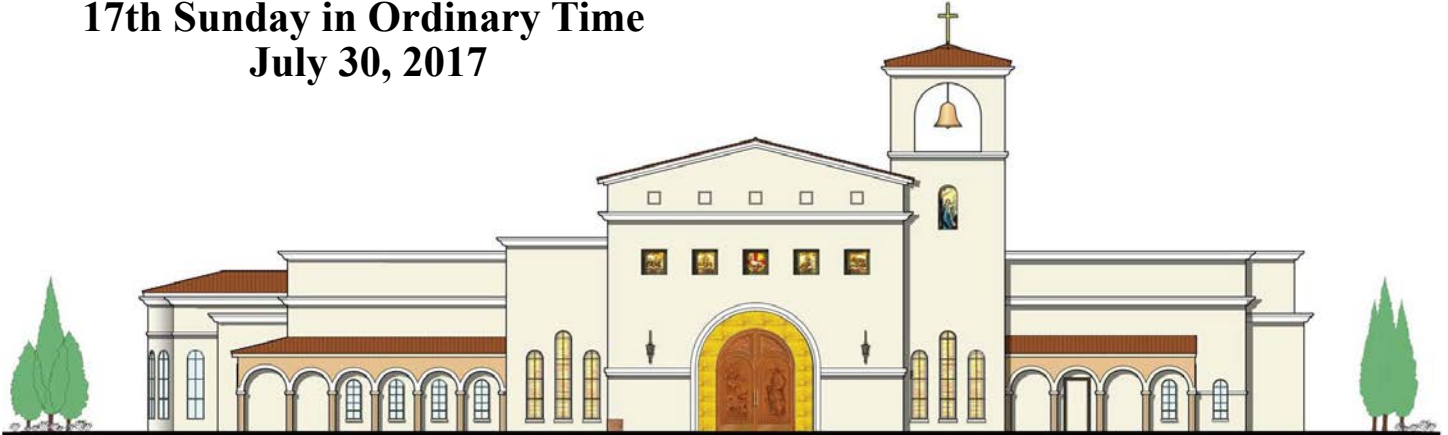

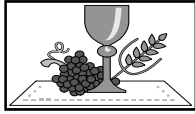

**Stewardship** - is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God's gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.

### Sunday Reading Reflection:

Jesus presents us with more parables in today's Gospel from St. Matthew. He opens the first one with "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field."

According to most biblical scholars and theologians who study and draw conclusions on Jesus' teachings, in this particular parable, and those which follow, the field is the world. The man who values the treasure is not any of us because we do not have anything with

which to purchase this treasure. The Man who gave all to buy this field was Jesus Himself.

And it is with joy that He gives all to buy the field, to save the world and each of us. What makes the treasure so wonderful that the Lord would give all, His very life? Each of us, in other words, each of you! Jesus gave everything to redeem the whole world to preserve a treasure it contains. He gave all because we His people are the treasure. Do we understand that? Do we consider that every time we approach the gift of the Eucharist we should?

A profound stewardship prayer is offered by the young king Solomon in today's first reading. He asks the Lord to give him an understanding heart, compassion towards God's people and the insight to distinguish right from wrong. An understanding heart, or wisdom, is a gift from God. It is a gift that enables us to make good decisions and prudent choices. Cultivating and sharing this gift is essential, especially when poor decisions and lack of compassion have consequences that can adversely affect the lives of others. Do we exercise good stewardship over the gift of wisdom? Do we share our compassionate hearts with others?

Un corazón atento, o con sabiduría, es un don de Dios. Es un don que nos permite tomar buenas decisiones y hacer elecciones prudentes. Es esencial cultivar y compartir este don, especialmente cuando las decisiones inadecuadas y la falta de compasión tienen consecuencias que pueden afectar desfavorablemente la vida de otros. ¿Ejercitamos nosotros una buena corresponsabilidad del don de la sabiduría? ¿Compartimos nuestros corazones compasivos con otros?

San Pablo no pudo haberlo puesto mejor, en su carta a los Romanos: "Tú eres amado más que usted sabrá jamás, por alguien que murió al conocerte." (Romanos 5:8).

### Reflexión de las lectura:

Jesús se nos presenta con más parábolas en el evangelio de San Mateo. Él abre la primera con "de nuevo, el reino de los cielos es semejante a un tesoro escondido en un campo, que un hombre encontró y se escondió; y de alegría sobre él va y vende todo lo que tiene y compra ese campo."

De acuerdo con la mayoría de los biblistas y teólogos que estudian y sacan conclusiones sobre las enseñanzas de Jesús, en esta parábola, y aquellos que siguen, el campo es el mundo. El hombre que valora el tesoro no es cualquiera de

### Catholic Teaching Ask Esther:

#### What is the difference between the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and “last rites”?

**Answer:** Before the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, anointing of the sick and the “last rites” were often done together. There was a tendency to wait as long as possible, and to have these rites celebrated in close proximity to death. The reforms after Vatican II went to great lengths to separate the rites associated with sickness and death and to distinguish the anointing of the sick from the rites to be used at the time of death.

The introduction to the rite of anointing of the sick states: “The Sacrament of Anointing is the proper sacrament for those Christians whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age” (No. 97). It goes on to say: “The priest should ensure that the abuse of delaying the reception of the sacrament does not occur, and that the celebration takes place while the sick person is capable of active participation” and “that those needing the sacrament should seek it at the beginning of a serious illness” (No. 99).

This sacrament is no longer seen as the primary rite associated with dying, but a dying person should be anointed if he or she has not been anointed earlier.

The rites properly described as “last rites” today are the celebration of viaticum, the Commendation of the Dying and the Prayers for the Dead. When someone is close to death (and has been anointed already), they should receive holy Communion for the last time (though this may be repeated if the person lingers in illness).

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, “The Eucharist should always be the last sacrament of the earthly journey, the ‘viaticum’ for ‘passing over’ to eternal life” (No. 1517). It also says: “Communion in the body and blood of Christ, received at this moment of ‘passing over’ to the Father, has a particular significance and importance. It is the seed of eternal life and the power of resurrection, according to the words of the Lord: ‘He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day’ [Jn 6:54]. The sacrament of Christ once dead and now risen, the Eucharist is here the sacrament of passing over from

death to life, from this world to the Father” (No. 1524).

Viaticum is complemented by the Commendation of the Dying — some of the most beautiful and powerful prayers in the Church’s repertoire. These should be said at the time of death or when death is clearly imminent. Then there are the Prayers for the Dead, which are intended for use after the person has died. These are meant to send the dead person on his or her way and to comfort those who are present.

It is ideal if a priest or deacon is present at the time of death, but this is not always feasible. In the absence of a priest or deacon, the Commendation of the Dying and the Prayers for the Dead may be said by one of those present.
