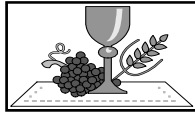

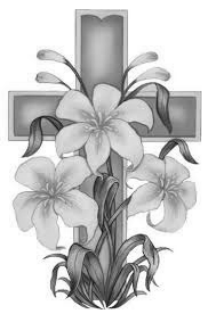

Stewardship – is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God's gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.

Sunday Reading Reflection:

"Your abundance at the present time should supply their needs, so that their abundance may also supply your needs." This is the fourth time in 2 Corinthians, chapter 8 that St. Paul addresses the issue of giving. What Paul is trying to explain is that the motivation for giving should be similar to God's motivation for gifting us. In the passage which constitutes today's Second Reading Paul says, "As you excel in every respect, in faith, discourse, knowledge, all

earnestness, and in the love we have for you, may you excel in this gracious act also."

In the original, Paul uses the old Greek word *charis* to describe the giving to which he is making reference. We can probably see that the roots of that word are very much the same as the roots of the word "charity." Giving and sharing are definitely the work of God's grace in us. In fact, our motivation should be very much the same as that of the Lord. He gives to us because of Who He is, not because of what or who we are.

We, too, must give if we wish to show holiness, or to at least aspire to it. That is also what we mean when we say that we are all called to stewardship, to be good stewards. It is one thing to be faithful, but it is

another to give. At times we may think there are too many collections, but it is the results of these opportunities to give which support the Church's work both locally and around the globe.

Reflexión de la lectura

"Su abundancia en el tiempo presente debe suplir sus necesidades, para que su abundancia también pueda satisfacer sus necesidades". Esta es la cuarta vez en 2 Corintios, capítulo 8, que San Pablo aborda el tema de dar. Lo que Pablo está tratando de explicar es que la motivación para dar debe ser similar a la motivación de Dios para obsequiarnos. En el pasaje que constituye la segunda lectura de hoy, Pablo dice: "Como se destacan en todos los aspectos, en la fe, el discurso, el conocimiento, toda la sinceridad y en el amor que tener

para usted, puede que sobresalga en este acto de gracia también".

En el original, Pablo usa la antigua palabra griega *charis* para describir la donación a la que hace referencia. Probablemente podamos ver que las raíces de esa palabra son muy parecidas a las raíces de la palabra "caridad". Dar y compartir son definitivamente el trabajo de la gracia de Dios en nosotros. De hecho, nuestra motivación debería ser muy similar a la del Señor. Nos lo da por Quien es, no por qué o quiénes somos.

Nosotros también debemos dar si queremos mostrar santidad o, al menos, aspirar a ella. Eso es también lo que queremos decir cuando decimos que todos estamos llamados a la corresponsabilidad, a ser buenos corresponsales. Una cosa es ser

fiel, pero otra es dar. A veces podemos pensar que hay demasiadas colecciones, pero es el resultado de estas oportunidades para dar apoyo al trabajo de la Iglesia tanto a nivel local como en todo el mundo.
