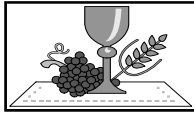

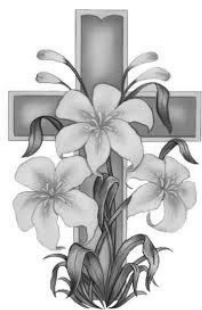

## Catholic Etiquette

### Mass Etiquette Part III: Things To Do And Not Do In Mass:

**Genuflection**, as we enter the row you should genuflect as a sign of reverence and respect for the Real Presence of Jesus in the tabernacle. To make a proper genuflection bend the right knee to touch the ground, it is a sign of our acknowledgement of Jesus' Divinity.

**Custom** dictates that when we have found our seat we kneel in prayer briefly. This is great opportunity to offer to God gratitude/thanksgiving or make our petitions that we intend to pray for during Mass.

**Bulletins should not be read during Mass.** Our focus should be on listening and participating in Mass. For this reason



## Etiqueta católica

### Etiqueta de la misa parte III: cosas que hacer y no hacer en la misa:

**Genuflexión**, cuando ingresemos a la fila, debe hacer una genuflexión como muestra de reverencia y respeto por la presencia real de Jesús en el tabernáculo. Para hacer una genuflexión adecuada dobla la rodilla derecha para tocar el suelo, es un signo de nuestro reconocimiento de la Divinidad de Jesús.

**La costumbre** dicta que, cuando hayamos encontrado nuestro asiento, nos arrodillaremos en oración brevemente. Esta es una gran oportunidad para ofrecer a Dios gratitud / acción de gracias o hacer nuestras peticiones por las cuales tenemos la intención de orar durante la Misa.

**Los boletines** no deben leerse durante la Misa. Nuestro enfoque debe estar en escuchar y participar en la Misa. Por esta razón, en los boletines de Resurrección se

### **Reception of Holy Communion**

**Bow** before receiving Holy Communion. If it is God, then show your respect with a bow of the head. This is an ancient practice that has continued until this day.

**Don't take the Eucharist in your hands** to dip yourself into the chalice. This is called intinction, and, according to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the act of intinction is reserved for the priest. (287)

**FOR Catholics** As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession see canon

### **Recepción de la Sagrada Comunión**

**Inclina** antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Si es Dios, muestra tu respeto con una inclinación de cabeza. Esta es una práctica antigua que ha continuado hasta este día.

**No tomes la Eucaristía** en tus manos para sumergirte en el cáliz. Esto se llama intincción y, de acuerdo con la Instrucción General del Misal Romano, el acto de intincción está reservado para el sacerdote. (287)

**Para Los Católicos** Como católicos, participamos plenamente en la celebración de la Eucaristía cuando recibimos la Sagrada Comunión. Se nos anima a recibir la Comunión devota y frecuentemente. Para estar debidamente dispuestos a recibir la Comunión, los participantes no deberían ser conscientes de un pecado grave y normalmente deberían haber ayunado durante una hora. Una persona que está consciente de un pecado grave no es para recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor sin una confesión sacramental previa.

**Para los cristianos no católicos:** Damos la bienvenida a nuestros hermanos cristianos

our fellow Christians to this celebration of the Eucharist as our brothers and sisters. We pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit in this Eucharist will draw us closer to one another and begin to dispel the sad divisions which separate us. We pray that these will lessen and finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us "that they may all be one" (Jn 17:21).

Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Holy Communion. See canon 844 § 4) & (canon 844 § 3). **For those not Receiving Communion:** All who are not receiving Holy Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another.

We should stay to the end for the closing prayer and blessing and the hymn that accompanies it, if there is one.

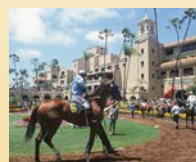
