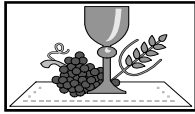

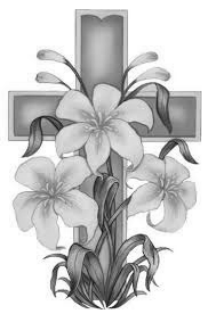

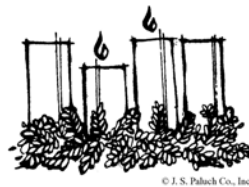

**Stewardship** – is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God’s gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.

### Sunday Reading Reflection:

The readings for the Second Week of Advent offer both encouragement and challenge as we reflect and prepare for the two “comings” of Christ — His coming as a baby on the great feast of Christmas, and the anticipation of His second coming at the end of time.

Our First Reading, from Baruch, is a wonderful reminder that God has triumphed over sin and death and that we — His faithful disciples — will live in the light of His glory one day. Until He comes again, we must remain faithful to Him as true disci-

ples and good stewards of all the gifts He has given us. While it can be tempting to give in to the materialism and calls for self-indulgence that surround us, (ironically more than ever at this time of year), this reading calls us back to the spiritual reality that this life is passing and that we are made for eternal life with God. We are called to prepare for eternal life by the way that we use our time, our talents and our treasure now.

The Gospel reading from Luke shows us how personal and detailed is God’s love for humanity as He prepared the way for Christ’s coming among us. We are told the precise time, place and person, John the Baptist, He appointed

to announce the arrival of our Savior.

John tells us how to celebrate to the fullest this first “coming” on the feast of Christmas and how to prepare for the second coming — through repentance.

This Advent, let’s turn away from any bad habits or sin that may have crept in to our lives and turn our hearts and minds back to Christ. This is what the stewardship way of life is all about —moving closer ever closer in relationship with Christ and imitation of Him, ready to celebrate His birth, with eyes fixed on eternal life with Him.

### Reflexión de las lectura

Las lecturas para la Segunda Semana de Adviento ofrecen tanto estímulo como desafío mientras reflexionamos y nos preparamos para las dos "venidas" de Cristo: su venida como bebé en la gran fiesta de Navidad y la anticipación de su segunda venida al final de los tiempos.

Nuestra primera lectura, de Baruch, es un maravilloso recordatorio de que Dios ha triunfado sobre el pecado y la muerte y que nosotros,

sus fieles discípulos, viviremos en la luz de su gloria un día. Hasta que Él regrese, debemos permanecer fieles a Él como verdaderos discípulos y buenos administradores de todos los dones que Él nos ha dado.

Si bien puede ser tentador ceder al materialismo y hacer un llamado a la autocomplacencia que nos rodea, (irónicamente más que nunca en esta época del año), esta lectura nos devuelve a la realidad espiritual que esta vida está pasando y que nosotros estamos hechos para la vida eterna con Dios. Estamos llamados a prepararnos para la vida eterna por la forma en que usamos nuestro tiempo, nuestros talentos y nuestro tesoro ahora.

La lectura del Evangelio de Lucas nos muestra cuán personal y detallado es el amor de Dios por la humanidad

cuando preparó el camino para la venida de Cristo entre nosotros. Se nos dice la hora, el lugar y la persona exactos, Juan el Bautista, que fue designado para anunciar la llegada de nuestro Salvador.

Juan nos dice cómo celebrar al máximo esta primera "venida" en la fiesta de Navidad y cómo prepararnos para la segunda venida, a través del arrepentimiento.

Este Adviento, apartémonos de cualquier mal hábito o pecado que pueda haber arrastrado a nuestras vidas y volvamos nuestros corazones y nuestras mentes a Cristo. De esto se trata el estilo de vida de la corresponsabilidad: acercarnos cada vez más en relación con Cristo e imitarlo, listo para celebrar su nacimiento, con los ojos fijados en la vida eterna con él.

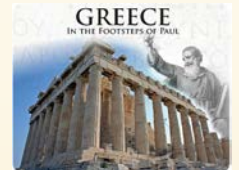

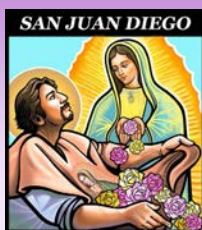

### **What is Posadas?**
