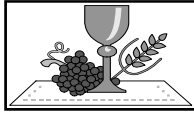

## .TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Monday of this week is Christmas Day in Russia and in much of the Orthodox world. This curious difference in schedule has a lot to do with how calendars have been developed and changed over the years. In the year 45 B.C. Julius Ceasar gave the empire his Julian Calendar, with the winter solstice on January 6. This put an end to a system in which officials called "pontiffs" were able to tweak the calendar by adding extra days in as needed. He invented two new months at that time, December and January; and in order to correct the mess the pontiffs had made, forced a year of 445 days on the empire in what he named "The Last Year of Confusion." The new months varied in number of days according to a complex schedule, but the calendar was still off by nearly twelve minutes a year, and lost a full day every 130 years.

Pope Gregory XIII reformed the calendar in 1583, but not everyone appreciated his efforts. England held out for two hundred years. The year 1700 was a leap year in England, but not in France; they were eleven days apart! George Washington was really born on February 11; when the Gregorian calendar was finally adopted in the English colonies shortly before the Revolution, he had to move his birthday to February 22. Now the calendars are thirteen days apart, which accounts for Russia's Julian calendar Christmas. And Caesar thought he had brought confusion to an end!

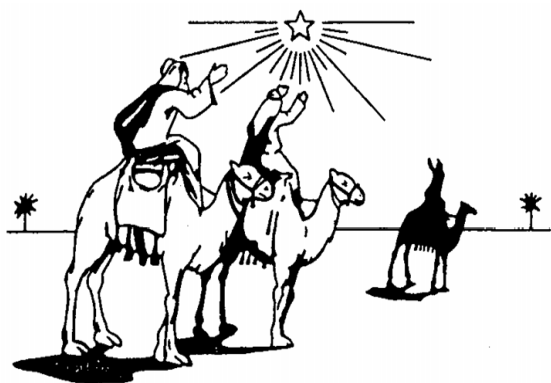

## Sunday Reading Reflection

### Epiphany of the Lord

In our celebration of the Epiphany, two interwoven themes are present in the readings today. God is beginning something new, and God gathers all of humanity to participate. For Isaiah, God’s bright light, manifested in the people of Israel, attracts and summons people from many nations to Jerusalem. In the letter to the Ephesians, God’s grace makes the Gentiles co-heirs and co-partners in the gospel. Matthew tells the story of the fulfillment of

God’s promises to Israel through the birth of Jesus, and simultaneously leading foreigners to share in these same promises. With the birth of Jesus, God chose a particular people, in a particular time and place, to enter most directly into the human story. Today’s readings teach that God did this in order to gather all people, all cultures, into unity with God. Like the magi, we are drawn into a journey toward God, becoming co-partners in God’s work.

### JOURNEY OF TRANSFORMATION

Tradition, poetry, and literature have long reflected upon the story of the magi. The journey of the magi indeed resonates with journeys in our own

lives. The journey is a search for a “king,” for what or who is of primary importance in life. The seekers lose direction and encounter obstacles and dangers. Searching for a king, the magi first come upon a false king, Herod. The reappearance of the star shows them the true path and leads to the true king.

For Matthew, the journey culminates in the magi’s worship of Jesus. They discover a king not clothed in grandeur, but wrapped in humility and simplicity. They begin to re-imagine what true royal power really is. Transformed by the journey, they embrace the humble king, Jesus.

## Reflexión de las lecturas

### La Epifanía del Señor

En nuestra celebración de la Epifanía, dos temas entrelazados están presentes en las lecturas de hoy. Dios está comenzando algo nuevo, y Dios reúne a toda la humanidad para participar. Para Isaías, la luz brillante de Dios, manifestada en el pueblo de Israel, atrae y convoca a personas de muchas naciones a Jerusalén. En la carta a los Efesios, la gracia de Dios hace que los gentiles sean co-herederos y compañeros en el Evangelio. Mateo cuenta la historia

del cumplimiento de las promesas de Dios a Israel a través del nacimiento de Jesús, y al mismo tiempo lleva a los extranjeros a compartir estas mismas promesas. Con el nacimiento de Jesús, Dios eligió a un

pueblo en particular, en un momento y lugar en particular, para entrar más directamente en la historia humana. Las lecturas de hoy enseñan que Dios hizo esto para reunir a todas las personas, todas las culturas, en unidad con Dios. Al igual que los magos, nos vemos atraídos por un camino hacia Dios, convirtiéndonos en socios en la obra de Dios.

### CAMINO DE TRANSFORMACIÓN

La tradición, la poesía y la literatura desde hace mucho tiempo reflexionan en la historia de los magos. El camino de los magos sin duda tiene impacto en los caminos de

nuestras propias vidas. El camino es una búsqueda de un “rey”, por lo que o por quién es de una importancia fundamental en la vida. Quienes buscan pierden la dirección y encuentran obstáculos y peligros. Al buscar a un rey, los magos primero llegan con un rey engañoso, Herodes. La reaparición de la estrella muestra el verdadero camino y los guía al verdadero rey.

Para Mateo, el camino termina cuando los magos adoran a Jesús. Ellos descubren a un rey que no está vestido de majestuosidad, sino cubierto con humildad y sencillez. Ellos comienzan a re imaginar lo que es el verdadero poder regio. Transformados por este camino, ellos aceptan a este rey humilde, Jesús.

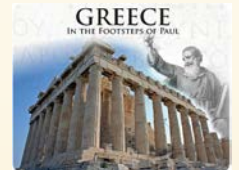
